

Position Description Summer Conservatory Instructional Aide Full-time, Seasonal, Non-Exempt position

Position Overview

Under the direction of the Artistic Learning Programs Manager, Instructional Aides will support and supervise students throughout their conservatory experience. Aides will serve as assistant instructors, assistant directors and activities supervisors in Cal Shakes' Summer Shakespeare Conservatories. Aides will also be responsible for taking and sharing production notes with production team, communicating with student parents and guardians, and tending to the emotional, social and physical needs and safety of a diverse group of young actors.

As a member of the Cal Shakes staff, you'll receive complimentary tickets to our productions. You'll also have the opportunity to engage in company dialogues about the art we create and the communities we touch.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Pre-Conservatory:
 - Assist with administrative projects as assigned; complete conservatory logistics; summer staff and camper orientations; Production prep; participate in trainings.
- At Conservatory:
 - Main responsibility is to create and maintain fun, productive and harmonious group interactions through consistent and fair discipline and bonding.
 - Oversee a group of student actors: manage check-in and check-out.
 - Assist Teaching Artists in classes: demonstrate skills within lesson; encourage participation.
 - Plan and teach Master classes
 - Lead group activities as needed; actively supervise lunchtime activities.
 - Plan/lead extracurricular events such as needed, for example: Talent Show
 - Work closely with the Director and Tech Coordinator on all aspects of production for Conservatory performances; for example: helping with paraphrasing, running lines, taking and giving line notes, stage management tasks.
 - Provide continuity and communication to TAs.
 - Participate in load-in day and finalizing production elements on behalf of the director.
- Post Conservatory:
 - Process feedback from students and parents; return production materials: props, costumes, etc.; assist with administrative projects as assigned.

Qualifications

You are an ideal candidate if you:

- Have an understanding of theatrical education.
- Have experience working with young people in an educational/theatrical setting.



- Have experience in theatrical rehearsal and production.
- Share with us a commitment to inclusion and equity
- Enjoy working in a diverse, creative, collaborative, and fast-paced environment
- Are self-motivated, responsible, and highly creative
- Have solid team playing skills and the ability to adapt
- Can think on your feet and problem-solve in a calm, professional manner.
- Exercise good judgment and give appropriate consideration to others
- Are comfortable working outside with an unpredictable climate

Special Environmental Factors

- Position requires that you work at our outdoor Amphitheater in Orinda.
- At the Bruns Amphitheater: extended standing, walking on uneven ground (hills, gravel, and rocks), working outdoors with no effective protection from weather for extended periods of time.
- The Bruns Amphitheater is most accessible by car. It is preferable that the employee have access to and operate a car in order to work at the Amphitheater, but Cal Shakes may be able to accommodate alternatives.
